I have used Carousel of IDEAS for over six years. In 2006 when I started teaching at Eaton School District, CO, there was no ELD curriculum in place. When CDE (Colorado Department of Education) came to observe our schools, their response was that the intervention piece was excellent.

Definitely yes!! Carousel makes my job as a teacher much easier! It gives me the structure and base I need so that I'm not always second guessing where I need to go. While having that base, it also provides a springboard to differentiate for my higher level students.

The integrated assessments give me proof that students are learning and mastering content. This is important as there are not many approved ELD assessments or progress monitoring tools to use.
