
Integrated English Language Development Programs and Screeners Lead to Significant Proficiency Gains at Turlock USD

In recent years, Turlock Unified School District (TUSD), located in California's Central Valley, has welcomed a growing number of English learners, many who speak no English and who have had limited access to formal education or technology. The district's dedicated English language development (ELD) teachers strive to create a welcoming and safe environment for ELs and newcomers to thrive. As the number of students they serve has grown, TUSD educators have expanded and enhanced the district's dedicated newcomer program to better support the increasingly diverse student body.

Cohesive and Integrated: TUSD's New Approach to English Learner Support

Before the pandemic, TUSD relied on a patchwork of assessment kits and ELD programs to support their ELs and newcomers. However, the increasing newcomer population highlighted the need for a more cohesive and comprehensive ELD program and an English language proficiency screener.

Recognizing this need, Alice Solis, the district's director of English learners, assessment, and special programs, and her team sought a more integrated solution. They had seen positive results with Ballard & Tighe's supplemental ELD products in the past and believed these tools could provide the consistency they were aiming for.



In March 2020, TUSD launched a district-wide pilot of several Ballard & Tighe products: Hands-On English (K-3), Frames for Fluency (K-5), Carousel of IDEAS (K-5), and the OnlineIPT, a K-12 language proficiency assessment solution. At the time of the pilot, two ELD teachers served 50 newcomers.

By the 2023–24 school year, the newcomer population had grown to 167 students. Data from the OnlineIPT indicated that students would need additional language support, leading to the hiring of a third ELD teacher and an ELD paraprofessional.

ELD Pilot Receives Enthusiastic Teacher Support

The response from district itinerant ELD teachers to the Ballard & Tighe pilot was overwhelmingly positive. "They loved it," Solis shared, noting their enthusiasm for the sentence frames, visuals, vocabulary cards, and big book read-alouds. Teachers found value in the structured chapters and guided lesson plans, which were missing from previous ELD products. These resources included scripted lessons and in-lesson assessments that provided clear steps for improving student proficiency.

"We were looking for something with a complete package," Solis said. "[We wanted] built-in lesson plans and research-based content that aligned with ELPAC and state standards." Solis hoped that this comprehensive approach would support TUSD in effectively meeting the needs of its diverse and growing student population.





Data-Driven Reports Facilitate Differentiated Student Support

TUSD mandates language proficiency screeners be used three times a year to provide teachers with data to identify areas where students need additional support. After implementing the OnlineIPT as their language proficiency screener, Solis noted that district itinerant newcomer teachers could more effectively front-load necessary data to other teachers. By regularly sharing IPT reports with all teachers, they can better support and differentiate instruction throughout the year during designated FLD instruction.





Impressive Growth Results


Since implementing the OnlineIPT, Solis observed an impressive 63% proficiency growth among the district's 167 newcomers. Additionally, the spring 2024 summative ELPAC reports indicated strong gains in language proficiency growth, solidifying newcomer success.

Solis was thrilled to inform parents and caregivers about the "significant growth" their children were making. "There were a few reports that showed jumps from level 1 proficiency to level 3," she shared, attributing this success to the supplemental Ballard & Tighe curricula and consistent use of OnlineIPT reports by teachers.

Solis emphasized that when teachers use Ballard & Tighe's research-based curricula, administer the OnlineIPT with fidelity, and feel confident due to the training and professional development they receive, substantial student growth in English language proficiency follows.

TUSD's ELD teachers appreciate how the OnlineIPT effectively targets specific areas where newcomers struggle, and the clear reports help teachers quickly identify where additional support is needed. Addressing the Needs of a Growing High School Newcomer Population

After witnessing the structure that Carousel of IDEAS, Frames for Fluency, and Hands-On English provided the district's K-5 ELs, Solis recognized the need for something similar for older students, a rapidly growing age group at TUSD. "In one week, we had 30 newcomers arriving from Afghanistan, India, Peru, and Argentina," Solis noted.

During the 2023–24 school year, the district piloted Champion of IDEAS (6–12). Previously, high school newcomer support was provided after class or on weekends. This schedule proved problematic as many students in this age group were working after-school jobs to help support their families. "We had minimal participation," Solis explained, "and now we know why." Consequently, the district moved to integrate Champion of IDEAS into the embedded intervention time within the school day.

After the first year of piloting Champion of IDEAS, the teachers using it are confident they can apply their learnings to expand and continue meeting the growing needs of high school newcomers.
