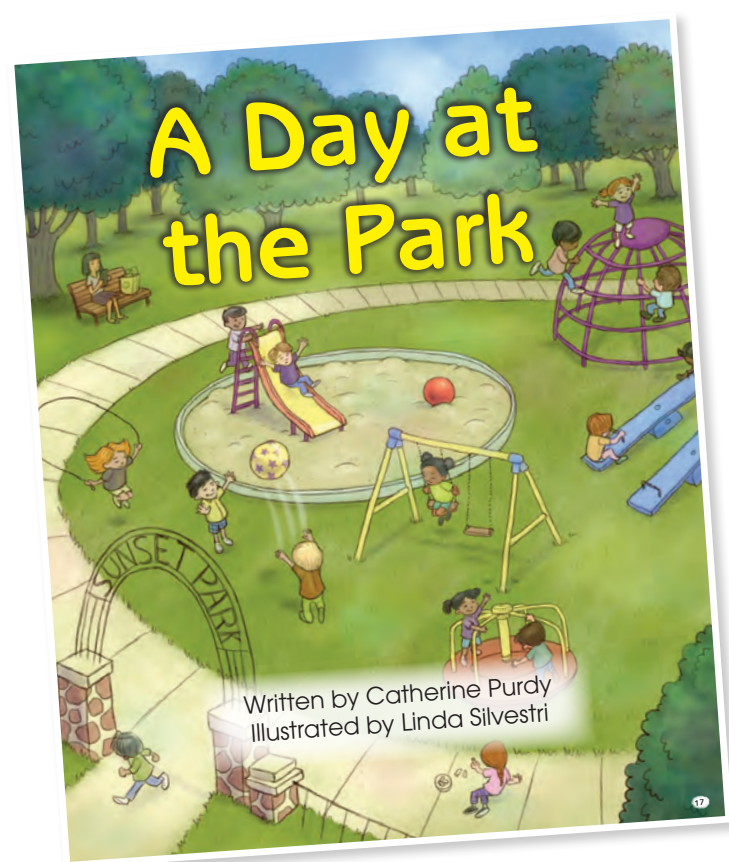

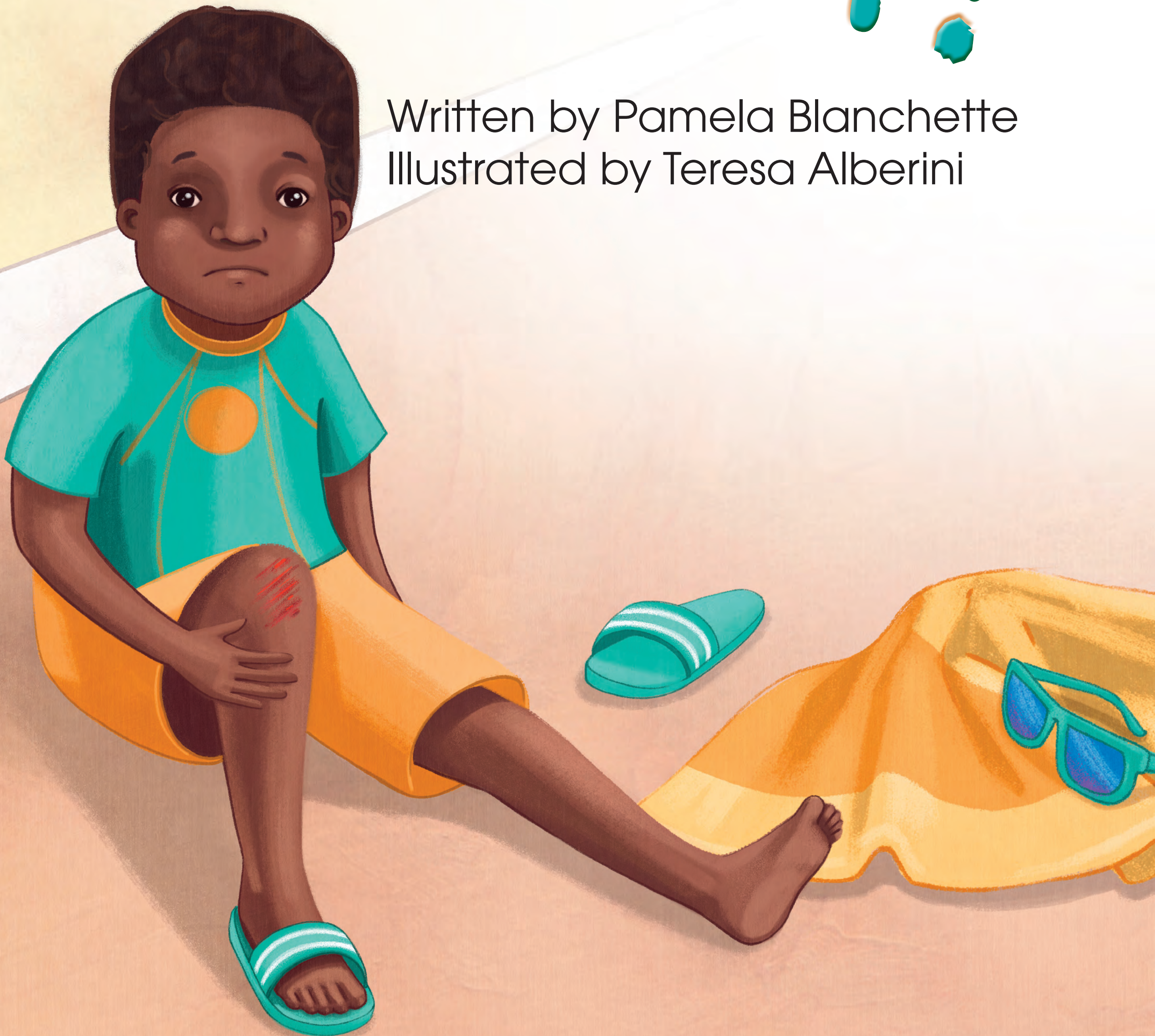

up and down.

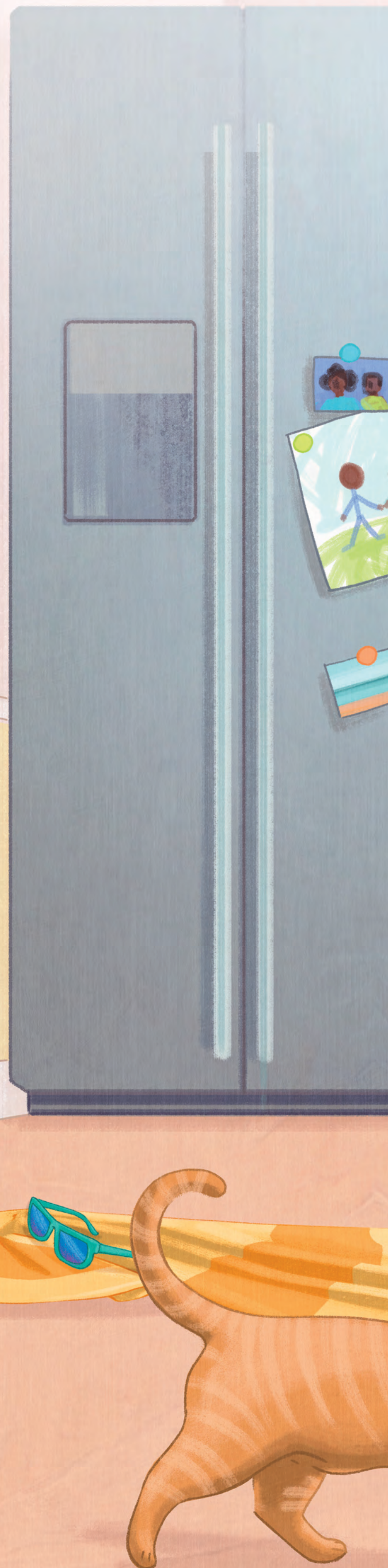
And boom! Down I fall!

“I want to swim!”



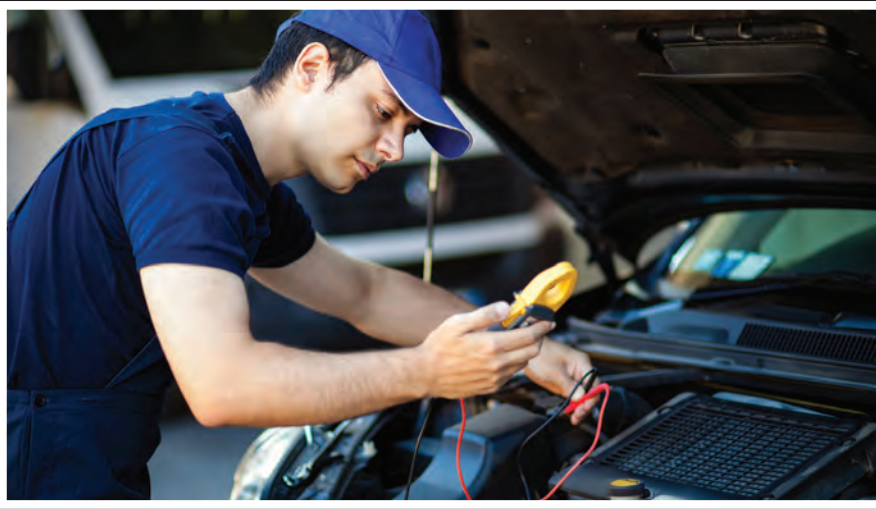
“You can swim, but be careful!”
