

**Pre-IPT Spanish, Remote Adaptation
TEST LEVEL SUMMARY**

At LEVEL A, a child can:

1. tell his or her name and age.
2. understand numbers one and two.
3. understand the names of basic body parts.
4. answer a simple “either/or” question.

At LEVEL B, a child can:

1. identify colors.
2. identify basic items of clothing and common objects.
3. answer a “yes/no” question.
4. choose a favorite from two options.

At LEVEL C, a child can

1. understand number concepts of one, two, and three and use them for counting.
2. describe contrast in size (big/bigger).
3. describe location using simple prepositions.
4. use the present progressive form to describe what someone is doing.
5. string several words or phrases together to express themselves.

At LEVEL D, a child can:

1. predict events.
2. express preferences.
3. describe events in the past tense.
4. understand a description of an event and retell it.
5. describe personal experiences using phrases or sentences.

At LEVEL E, a child can:

1. understand and use ordinal numbers first and second.
2. analyze and identify a difference.
3. evaluate events and give advice using the appropriate form of “deber.”
4. talk about personal experiences using the past tense.
5. talk about future plans.

Note: This Test Level Summary is a list of competencies that are assessed by the Pre-IPT. There may be only one test item in the test assessing a given skill. The Test Level Summary is simply an indicator of the oral language competencies that a student possesses.
